

MANDATORY Site Protocols for COVID-19 Virus

The following are health and safety procedures to be followed at this site by all CRD Design Build personnel and all trades, suppliers, and vendors providing any services to CRD and its customers. It is for the protection of your fellow workers, your families, our customers, their families, and you. These rules are vitally important and must be followed explicitly. Anyone refusing to follow these procedures will be immediately removed from this site.

1. DO NOT enter if you are sick or showing any flu-like symptoms. Notify CRD immediately if you are ill.
2. Follow proper procedures as directed by health professionals for limiting transmission of the virus.
3. Notify CRD IMMEDIATELY if you have come into contact with anyone you suspect has Coronavirus.
4. Notify CRD management if you have traveled or intend to travel outside of the United States.
5. Designated wash-up and bathroom areas will be the ONLY locations used for these activities. DO NOT use other areas of the home other than designated areas.
6. Living areas of the home which do not require access for construction purposes are strictly OFF LIMITS to all CRD employees, sub-trades, etc. These areas will be specifically labeled NO-GO ZONES. Please notify the homeowners and CRD staff if you will need access to NO-GO ZONES prior to entering.
7. Traffic and access points will be limited to minimal numbers and paths. Access property by one door only if possible and follow one route in and out of the home if possible. The more segregated these areas from the homeowners and their living spaces, the better. Main renovation entrances will be labelled.
8. Wash your hands before and after using the bathroom.
9. Wash your hands before and after eating.
10. If you are eating on site, bring bag lunches only. If you leave the site to purchase food, eat off site and wash your hands prior to re-entering the site.
11. ALL high-touch contact points in the construction area shall be disinfected by CRD personnel TWICE DAILY. Designated times will be noon and end-of-day. Examples include doorknobs, handrails, bathroom fixtures, light switches, hand tools you are using, any other common contact points.
12. REDUCE CLOSE CONTACT WITH OTHERS.
